MAKING A TRANSFORMATIONAL IMPACT

- ♥ **40,916** total days of safety provided for children in crisis.
- ♥ **3,106** middle and high school students participated in danger awareness and violence prevention presentations.
- ♥ **97** teen moms and babies received support for a healthy start through Gerard House and M.O.M. programs.
- ♥ **85** youth accessed the Safe Place crisis line and were relocated to a safe place.
- ♥ **Garver House** opened in October as Kansas' only home for victims of human trafficking.
- ♥ WCH now has **68** foster homes to help provide 24/7 emergency care for children 0-12 - and more are needed!

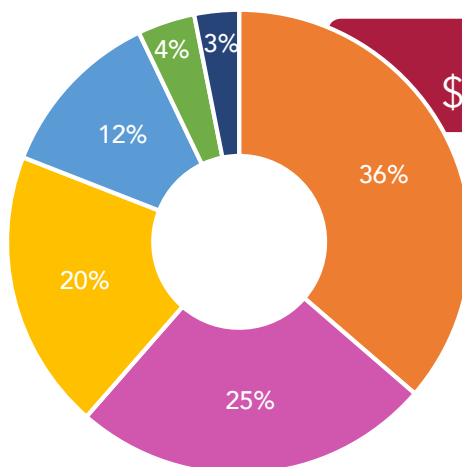

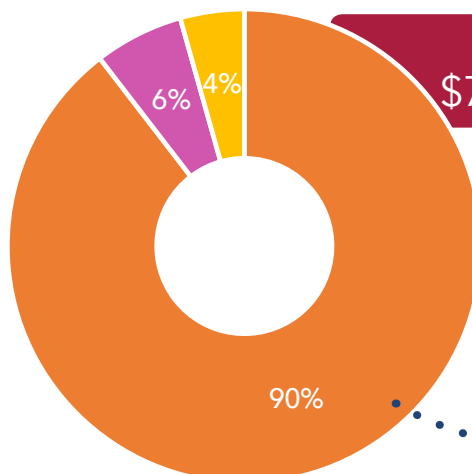
